Dear Ms. Nagle:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) submitted a request on July 22, 2011, for an amendment to the Bridge to Reform Demonstration (BTR) Project (11-W-00193/9) to reallocate funds within the Safety Net Care Uncompensated Care Pool (SNCP) for Demonstration Year (DY) 6. This request was submitted in accordance with paragraphs 7 and 35.a.iv of the Special Terms and Conditions (STCs). The original amendment request is attached.

DHCS is requesting that this amendment request be considered at the same time as the Community Based Adult Services (CBAS) amendment. DHCS is including with this submission, documentation of the Health Care Coverage Initiative (HCCI) allocations. As the chart demonstrates, the HCCI allocations for the participating counties for the extension period and demonstration year 6 (DY6) only result in approximately \$184 million total computable HCCI SNCP funding. Based on this documentation, DHCS is requesting that \$176 million of HCCI funding be rolled over into the SNCP Uncompensated Care Limit.
