Subject: Montana Section 1115 HEART Demonstration Special Terms and Conditions Acceptance

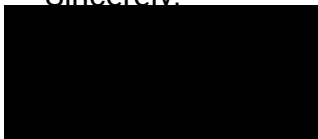
Dear Ms. Buschmann:

Montana accepts the Section 1115 Montana Healing and Ending Addiction through Recovery and Treatment (HEART) Demonstration (Project Number 11-W-00395/8) Special Terms and Conditions as presented in the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) letter dated February 26, 2024.

Under this demonstration, Montana Medicaid will be able to provide services to eligible Medicaid beneficiaries for contingency management services, pre-tenancy and tenancy support services, and pre-release services. The demonstration will allow Montana to provide essential treatment for Medicaid members with Stimulant Use Disorder, critical supports for those experiencing housing instability, and a better transition back to the community for individuals leaving incarceration.
