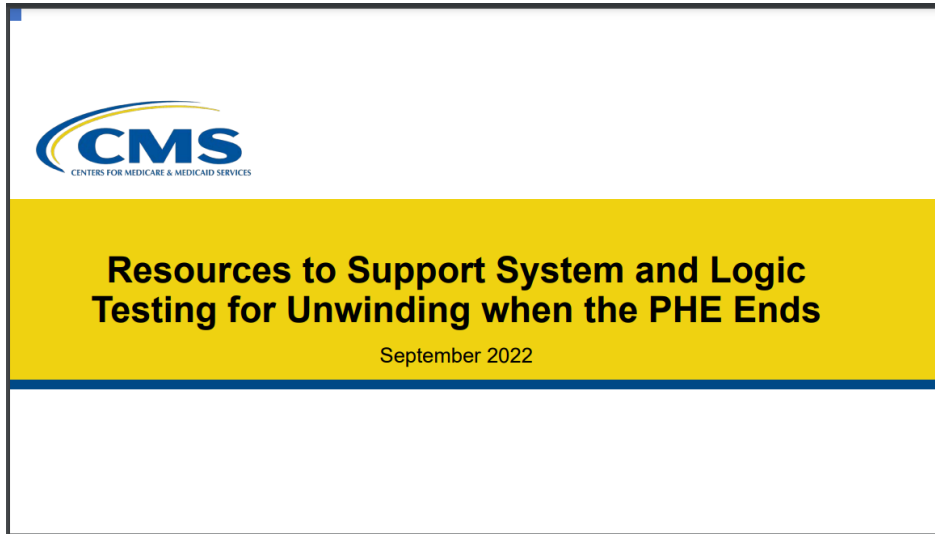

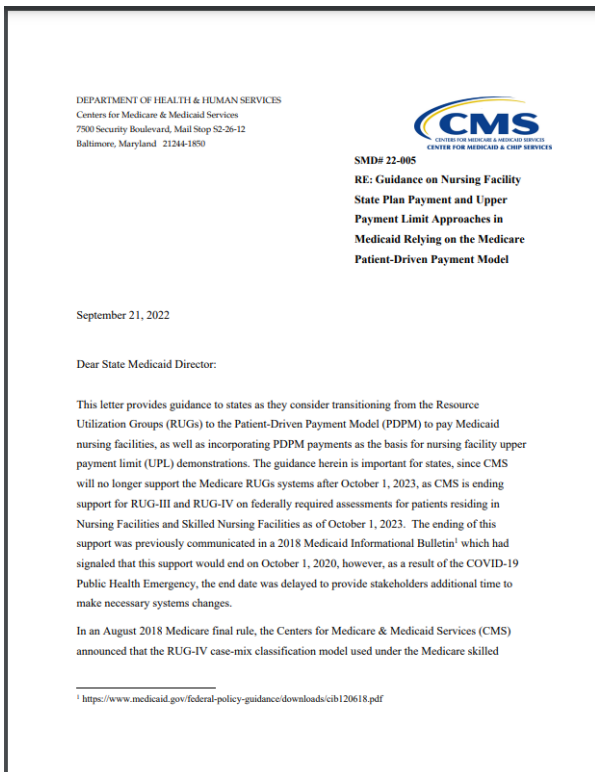

您或您的家庭或目前是否透過 Medicaid 或兒童健康保險計畫 (Children's Health Insurance Program, CHIP) 取得健康計畫? 如果是, 您可能很快就需要採取措施以確保您可以繼續投保。不久後, 各州將依據 Medicaid 和 CHIP 資格審查。這表示某些具有 Medicaid 或 CHIP 的人員可能會無法投保這些計畫。但是, 他們可能有資格透過 Health Insurance Marketplace\* 購買健康計畫, 並取得該計畫的協助支付費用。

下列是您可以進行的一些前置作業。

**確保您的地址是最新的**  
確保您所在的州和您目前的郵寄地址、電話號碼、電子信箱或其他聯絡資訊。如此, 他們可以就您的 Medicaid 或 CHIP 承保範圍與您聯絡。

**檢查您的電子信箱**  
您所在的州將寄一封關於您的 Medicaid 或 CHIP 承保範圍的信函給您。此封信函會讓您知道您是否需要填寫續保申請表以查看您是否仍具有 Medicaid 或 CHIP 的承保資格。如果您收到續保申請表, 請填寫並立即將其寄回您所在的州。此舉可以幫助您避免保險出現空窗期。

**如果您不符合 Medicaid 或 CHIP 的承保資格怎麼辦?**  
如果您或您的家庭或不再符合 Medicaid 或 CHIP 的承保資格, 則您可以透過 Health Insurance Marketplace\* 購買健康計畫。Marketplace 計畫具備下列特色:

- 經濟實惠。五分之四的投保者可以找到每月費用低於 10 美元的計畫。
- 全方位。大多數計畫涵蓋處方藥、醫生門診、緊急照護、醫院就診等。

請瀏覽 [HealthCare.gov](https://www.HealthCare.gov) 尋找 Marketplace 計畫, 並查看您是否可以節省保費。申請時, 別忘記提供有關您的家庭、收入以及您所在州近期對您的 Medicaid 或 CHIP 承保範圍所做出的資格判定。
