(b) Distribution of GME in the Event of a Hospital Closure or Hospital Acquisition During or After SFY 2024: In the event of a hospital closure or hospital acquisition, GME allocations that would have been provided to the closed hospital are to be redistributed to the acquiring hospital. If the acquiring hospital is not receiving GME FTEs from the closed or acquired hospital, the GME amount will be redistributed to all eligible hospitals by applying the current SFY GME payment formula excluding the closed or acquired hospital from the payment formula.
