Your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) number 9, submitted on September 22, 2010, has been approved. This amendment has a retroactive effective date of October 1, 2009, for the establishment of a prospective payment system for federally qualified health centers and rural health clinics. This amendment also establishes that Alabama's Title XXI dental benefits are compliant with Section 501 of the Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009 (CHIPRA).
