The title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPAs) #4 submitted April 16, 2009 has been approved. Amendment #4, effective April 1, 2009, makes technical changes to align Arkansas' State plan with current practice in the State. The current income level is up to and including 200 percent of the Federal poverty level (FPL) for the ARKids B 1115 demonstration children that are funded by CHIP. Additionally, the State deleted the references to the ARKids B opt-out provision and clarifies that the Primary Care Case Management (PCCM) is now included in the section ARHealth Network 1115 demonstration.
