The title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) #6, submitted June 15, 2010, has been approved. This amendment has a retroactive effective date of July 1, 2010. This SPA allows Delaware to obtain Federal matching funds to expand eligibility to uninsured non-citizen targeted low-income children, who have countable family incomes up to and including 200 percent of the Federal poverty level (FPL), and who are lawfully residing in the United States, as permitted by section 214 of the Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009 (CHIPRA).
