We are pleased to inform you that your State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) State plan amendment submitted June 30, 2008 has been approved. This amendment revises the SCHIP State plan and allows lowa to grant hardship exemptions for premium payments to SCHIP enrollees who meet income requirements and who reside in a county that has been declared a national disaster be FEMA or the Governor or is designated as a county requiring Individual Assistance. SCHIP enrollees will remain enrolled even if they do not pay premiums for the months of June and July 2008.

This amendment has a retroactive effective date of June 1, 2008.
