Your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) number 16, submitted on March 10, 2011, has been approved. This SPA allows Iowa to implement Express Lane Eligibility under Section 203 of the Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009. This SPA has a retroactive effective date of July 1, 2010.

It is our understanding that the State has agreed to revise the Medicaid application to comply with Section 1902(e)(13)(F) of the Social Security Act. This section requires an Express Lane Agency (Iowa Department of Human Services – Medicaid)) to notify the child's family that their information will be shared with the Hawk-I program solely for purposes of determining initial eligibility for child health assistance under the State CHIP plan. This will also ensure that the family may elect to not have their information disclosed for such purposes.
