I am pleased to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has approved your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) state plan amendment (SPA) number LA-14-0003, submitted on January 17, 2014, related Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI) Eligibility with an effective date of January 1, 2014.
