We are pleased to inform you that the title XXI State Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) submitted June 22, 2009, with additional information submitted on November 24, 2009, has been approved. This amendment expands health care coverage to children, with family incomes from 185 percent up to and including 300 percent of the Federal poverty level; provides for a premium assistance option under section 2105(c)(10) of the Social Security Act, as amended by the Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009 and exempts temporary income earned in working for the decennial Census from the eligibility calculations for Soon-To-Be-Sooners program applicants and enrollees.

This SPA has different effective dates for each of these changes: July 1, 2009, for the Census income; and January 1, 2010, to permit the expansion.
