We are informing you that your Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State Plan Amendment (SPA) #13 submitted August 10, 2009, has been approved.

This amendment allows Oregon to implement the Express Lane Eligibility (ELE) option under the title XXI State plan, per section 203 of Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009 (CHIPRA), using the *Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP)* and the *National School Lunch Program (NSLP)* as the express lane eligibility agencies that will be operating to perform a simplified eligibility determination process and expedited enrollment of eligible children in CHIP.
