Your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) number 16, submitted on March 28, 2011, has been approved. This amendment allows Oregon to expand coverage to unborn children with family income up to 185 percent of the Federal poverty level (FPL) in Columbia, Crook, Douglas, Jefferson, Josephine, Morrow, Union and Wasco counties. This SPA has an effective date of July 1, 2011.
