Your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) number 11, submitted on April 23, 2012, has been approved. This SPA implements express lane eligibility (ELE) at time of CHIP renewal, using adjusted gross income from Utah State Tax Commission, effective September 1, 2011. It also implements presumptive eligibility in CHIP, effective April 1, 2012.
