We are pleased to inform you that your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State Plan Amendment (SPA) #11, submitted on June 28, 2011, has been approved.

This amendment implements administrative changes to Virginia's CHIP (FAMIS) plan. Specifically, this SPA, 1) implements the online administrative renewal process, effective October 1, 2010; 2) reflects changes to the amount appropriate by the General Assembly for the Virginia Children's Medical Security Insurance Plan Trust Fund, effective July 1, 2010; and 3) enhances application options with the addition of electronic signature capability, effective July 1, 2010.
