Citation	The State has established a program under which it will contract with one or more recovery audit contractors (RACs) for the purpose of identifying overpayments and underpayments of Medicaid claims under

	$\checkmark$ The State is seeking an exception to establishing such program for the following reasons: Arizona needs approximately 12 months to incorporate identification of under payments into the current RAC contract, which meets all other statute requirements. Incorporation of underpayment identification will take place by April 1, 2012. By April 1, 2012, Arizona will submit to CMS a revised SPA which will include information on the payment methodology that will be used for underpayments.
