We are pleased to enclose a copy of approved Connecticut State plan amendment (SPA) No. 09-015. This proposed plan submitted to my office on June 29, 2009 transmitted an amendment to your Department's approved Title XIX State plan proposing to amend Title XIX of Connecticut's State Plan by using §1902 (r)(2) and §1931 of the Social Security Act (the Act) to disregard, for certain mandatory and optional categorically needy and medically needy Medicaid eligibility groups, all wages paid by the U.S. Census Bureau related to temporary employment related to the decennial census activities. The approval for CT 09-015 is effective April 1, 2009 as requested.
