We have reviewed the proposed amendment to the Florida Medicaid State Plan that was submitted under transmittal number 11-016 and received in the Regional Office on December 28, 2011. This amendment allows self-direction for the less than 21 years old population eligible to self-direct their State Plan personal care services. It also deletes Case Management, Case Aide, Community Support Coordination and Support Coordination services as these are not self-directed. Further, it adds the iBudget Waiver and services offered under that waiver in order for self-direction consumers to continue participating in the Consumer Directed Care Plus (CDC+) program.

Based on the information provided, we are now ready to approve Florida SPA 11-016 as of March 19, 2012. The effective date of this amendment is October 1, 2011. The signed HCFA-179 and the approved plan pages are enclosed.
