#### 3. For children under Section 1902(a)(10)(i)(VII) and 1902(l)(1)(D)of the Act (children who were born after September 30, 1983 and have attained age 6 but have not attained age 19), subject to 1902(r)(2):

Disregard the difference in income between a gross income standard of 133% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) and a net income standard of 100% FPL for children covered under Sections 1902(a)(10)(i)(VII) and 1902(l)(1)(D)of the Act.
