# K. Nursing Facility Quality Assurance Assessment Pass-Through and Quality Assurance Rate Add-On

- Quality assurance assessment pass-through. Effective the first day of the quarter following approval from CMS a quality assurance assessment pass-through rate shall be added to the Medicaid reimbursement rate as otherwise calculated pursuant to Section 4.19-D. The quality assurance assessment pass-through rate shall be equal to the quality assurance assessment Medicaid cost divided by Medicaid patient days.
- Quality assurance assessment rate add-on. Effective the first day of the quarter following approval from CMS, a quality assurance rate add-on of \$10.00 per patient day shall be added to the Medicaid reimbursement rates as otherwise calculated pursuant to Section 4.19-D.
