We have reviewed the proposed amendment to Attachment 4.19-A of your Medicaid State plan submitted under transmittal number (TN) 09-018. Effective July 1, 2009, this amendment proposes to increase reimbursement rates for Medicaid Inpatient Psychiatric Hospital Services for Individuals Under 21 furnished by Psychiatric Medical Institute for Children (PMIC) facilities. Specifically, rates paid to facilities under this amendment will be set at reasonable costs subject to a Statewide payment limit in the case of non-State facilities.

We conducted our review of your submittal according to the statutory requirements at sections 1902(a)(2), 1902(a)(13), 1902(a)(30), 1903(a) and 1923 of the Social Security Act and the implementing Federal regulations at 42 CFR 447 Subpart C. We are pleased to inform you that Medicaid State plan amendment 09-018 is approved effective July 1, 2009. We are enclosing the HCFA-179 and the amended pages.

During our review, we did note an inconsistency with the treatment of certain ancillary services included in a child's care plan. To be considered part of the psychiatric under 21 benefit, it is not sufficient for the services to be included in a child's care plan. The services must also be included in the PMIC's charge for an inpatient service and Medicaid payment is made to the facility through its reimbursement rate.
