Enclosed is a copy of the approved State Plan Amendment (SPA), Transmittal Number 10-15, which allows the State to establish programs to contract with one or more Medicaid Recovery Audit Contractors (RAC), in accordance with Section 6411 of the Affordable Care Act. The purpose of the Medicaid RAC is to identify overpayments and underpayments to recoup overpayments under the State Plan and under any waiver of the State Plan.

Maryland is hereby granted an exception to Section 6411 of the Affordable Care Act. This approved exception allows the State to continue to collect overpayments and the contingency fee directly from providers, in accordance with previously enacted State regulations. The contingency fee will then be paid to the Medicaid RAC, and the recovered amounts will be returned to the State and Federal Governments, based on the State's Federal Medical Assistance Percentage.

The effective date for this amendment is October 1, 2010. The signed CMS-179 form and the approved State Plan pages are enclosed.
