Enclosed is a copy of the approved State Plan Amendment (SPA), Transmittal Number 11-20. This SPA, in accordance with Section 113 of the Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act (CHIPRA), eliminates the previous requirements for deemed newborn Medicaid eligibility that the newborn must come home from the hospital to live with the mother, remain a member of the mother's household, and that the mother remain eligible for Medicaid, or would remain eligible if still pregnant. By virtue of this change, all newborns born to women covered by Medicaid for the child's birth, including coverage of an alien for labor and delivery as emergency medical services, are now covered as mandatory categorically needy.

The effective date for this amendment is October 1, 2011. The signed CMS-179 form and the approved State Plan pages are enclosed.
