We are now ready to approve State plan amendment (SPA) No. 10-011; attached you will find an approved copy of the SPA. This SPA is effective September 1, 2010 as requested.

This SPA transmitted an amendment to your approved Title XIX State plan to assure comparability amount, scope and duration of services made available to categorically and medically needy populations in the State plan. This amendment clarifies that all services provided for medically needy groups are identical in amount, duration, and scope as those for categorically needy groups.
