We have reviewed the proposed amendment to Attachment 4.19-A of your Medicaid State plan submitted under transmittal number (TN) 11-12. This amendment provides for a trend increase of four percent (4.0%) in inpatient hospital payment rates effective for dates of service beginning July 1, 2011. This amendment also clarifies audit and record keeping requirements associated with the independent disproportionate share hospital audits, updates references to other payment provisions in the State plan, and revises the payment schedule for enhanced graduate medical education payments.
