Dear Dr. Splinter:

We have reviewed the proposed amendment to your Medicaid State Plan submitted under Transmittal Number 10-28. This state plan amendment reduces the rates paid for targeted case management services for high risk pregnant women, first time pregnant women and their infants, and developmentally disabled children 0-3 years of age by 3.25% effective on or after April 1, 2010.

In the future, when the State submits a State Plan Amendment (SPA) that may impact Indians or Indian health providers, CMS will look for evidence of the State's tribal consultation process for that SPA. Pursuant to section 1902 (a) (73) of the Act added by section 5006 (e) of the Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the State must submit evidence to CMS regarding the solicitation of advice prior to submission of the SPA. This consultation must include all federally recognized tribes, Indian Health Service and Urban Indian Organizations within the state.

Transmittal Number 10-28 is approved with an effective date of April 1, 2010 as requested. A copy of the HCFA-179, dated June 30, 2010 is enclosed along with the approved plan pages.
