The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has completed its review of Oregon State Plan Amendment (SPA) Transmittal Number 12-14 Community First Choice (CFC). This amendment authorizes the home and community-based attendant services and supports to the Medicaid state plan under the authority of Section 1915(k) of the Social Security Act (the Act). This amendment also authorizes Oregon to apply excess income determined under 42 CFR 435.726, to both 1915(c) waiver and 1915(k) services, for individuals eligible for Medicaid under section 1902(a) (10)(A)(ii)(VI) of the Act who continue to meet all of the 1915(c) waiver requirements and who are receiving at least one 1915(c) waiver service a month.

This SPA is approved effective July 1, 2013, as requested by the state. This approval does not relieve Oregon of its obligations under the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Olmstead v. L.C., 527 U.S. 581, 119 S.Ct. 2176 (1999), the (Olmstead decision).

Upon publication of the final regulation for the home and community based criteria found at 42 CFR 441.530, Oregon will need to come into compliance with any requirements imposed by the final regulations not already met by the state.
