This amendment addresses Section 4107 of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) that requires Oregon to have comprehensive tobacco cessation services for pregnant women, including both counseling and pharmacotherapy, without cost sharing.

This SPA is approved effective April 1, 2013, as requested by the state.
