We have reviewed the Utah State Plan Amendment (SPA) 11-014, received in the Denver Regional Office on September 30, 2011. The State of Utah proposes to change its payment rate from average wholesale price (AWP) to Utah Wholesale Price (UWP) for the period of July 1, 2011 through February 20, 2012, when (AWP) was not available from the national pharmaceutical pricing data service. The UWP is determined by multiplying the wholesale acquisition cost (WAC) times 1.2 to equal AWP and then discounted 17.4 percent. Effective February 21, 2012, a new pricing data service will be supplying AWP and the reimbursement formula will return to AWP minus 17.4 percent. Utah also proposes to remove over-the-counter, nondrug items from its list of optional coverage drugs. Based on the information provided, we are pleased to inform you that SPA 11-014 is approved with an effective date of November 1, 2011.
