STATE PLAN AMENDMENT REQUIREMENT

We are taking this opportunity to remind all States that a State plan amendment must be submitted to the appropriate regional office whenever a State proposes to change reimbursement methodologies or dispensing fees under the Medicaid drug program. It has come to our attention that some States may be planning to change reimbursement amounts or methodologies or dispensing fees to pharmacists without submitting a State plan amendment. Please ensure that any change, whether it be an increase or a decrease in reimbursement for drugs, must be approved through the State plan process as specified in current drug regulations at 42 CFR 447.301-333.

NEW LABELERS
