WEST POINT PHARMA (LABELER #59591)

West Point Pharma has informed HCFA that states continue to submit quarterly invoices for their products requesting rebates for substantial utilization, despite the fact that this company has sold absolutely no products since March 1, 1995. Considering this fact, it seems likely that most supplies of labeler 59591 products have been exhausted before now and utilization should be almost non-existent.

Since generic substitutes are widely available for all these drugs, West Point Pharma has requested that we ask all states to assure that pharmacies submitting bills for these products are using the correct NDC number.

REINSTATED LABELER

Halsey Drug Company, Inc. (Labeler Code 00879) has signed a new rebate agreement and will be reinstated in the drug rebate program <u>effective April 1, 1998</u>. New personnel at this company are busy identifying missing quarterly pricing and computing interest for the late payment of rebates.
