The heparin and saline-filled flush syringes listed above do not meet the definition of covered outpatient drugs under section 1927 (k) of the Social Security Act. We are currently searching the MDR database for heparin and saline-filled flush syringes and will notify states as soon as we become aware of other products which should be deleted from the database. If you are aware of such devices in the program, please notify CMS.

HEPARIN/SALINE FLUSH SYRINGES & OTHER NON-DRUG PRODUCTS

It has come to our attention that manufacturers continue to report non-drug products to CMS, such as certain heparin/saline flush syringes, for inclusion in the Medicaid Drug Rebate Program (the program), and that states continue to cover them. When CMS discovers a non-drug product, we contact the manufacturer to notify it of the product(s) deletion from the program, and we notify states of the deletion of the product from our Medicaid Drug Rebate database.

Non-drug products are not eligible for coverage under the Medicaid Drug Rebate Program. States that discover non-drug products in CMS's quarterly data file should contact the Operations Team (see Section O of the Operations Guide) so that we may confirm their status and remove them if appropriate.

Ortho-Evra®. (00062-1920) REPLACEMENT PATCH BY ORTHO PHARMACEUTICAL CORPORATION

Ortho Pharmaceutical Corporation (OPC) makes the birth control patch Ortho-Evra. The patch comes in a box of three, intended for 3 weeks of use. Another package size contains one replacement patch intended to be dispensed in the event that the user has a problem with the patch, such as adhesive failure. OPC has implemented a replacement patch program, which is available to state Medicaid programs, as long as the replacement patch is used for replacement purposes and not as an initial script.
