On February 26, 2024, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) approved Montana's (the "state") amendment to the section 1115(a) demonstration titled, "Healing and Ending Addiction through Recovery and Treatment Demonstration" ("HEART") (Project Number 11-W-00395/8). With this approval, CMS is transferring a portion of the state's accumulated budget neutrality savings from the state's section 1115(a) demonstration, titled "Waiver for Additional Services and Populations" ("WASP") (Project Number 11-W-00181/8).

The transfer of \$600,000 of the WASP demonstration's budget neutrality savings to the HEART demonstration is described in Special Terms and Condition (STC) 92 of the HEART demonstration. Further, this transfer will be reflected in the WASP demonstration's budget neutrality monitoring workbooks.
