We have reviewed the proposed Maine State Plan Amendment (SPA) to Attachment 4.19-B ME-22-0024, which was submitted to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) on June 24, 2022. This plan amendment sets the rate for optometry, chiropractic, and podiatry services supplies at the lower of provider charges or 72.4% of the current Maine Medicare rate and by fee schedule for such services not covered by Medicare.
