

Program Support for States Promoting Community Integration - Long-Term Services and Supports State Selection Factors

The following factors will be used to review each state's Expression of Interest.

1. General Information For All States:

Factor: Commitment and Leadership of State Team

- Has the state designated a Medicaid IAP program lead (point person from Medicaid agency)?
- Has the state designated other Medicaid staff for this work?
- Is the proposed team lead well-positioned within the state to marshal resources, as needed, for this work?
- Does the proposed team have the right composition of members given the scope of its work, and is the Medicaid Director involved?

2. General Information For All States:

Factor: Expected Outcomes

• Does the state's program support needs align with IAP's proposed approach and content areas? Do the state's goals align with IAP's goals for this activity?

3. For States Interested in Medicaid Housing-Related Services and Partnerships:

Factor: State Needs and Interest

- Supporting Housing Tenancy Track:
 - Has state clearly articulated its program support needs with regard to supporting housing tenancy?
- State Medicaid-Housing Agency Partnerships Track:
 - Has the state clearly articulated its program support needs with regard to building Medicaid-Housing Agency partnerships?
 - Has the state provided evidence of its willingness to create a Medicaid-housing agency partnership from both the Medicaid and the housing Agency?

4. For States Interested in Incentivizing Quality and Outcomes in Community-Based LTSS Programs (IQO)

Factor: Clearly Articulated Program Needs and Experience

- Planning an IQO Strategy Track:
 - Has the state clearly articulated its program support needs with regard to planning an IQO strategy in community-based LTSS programs?
- Implementation of an IQO Track:
 - Has the state provided evidence of current activity in designing and/or implementing an IQO strategy for community-based LTSS programs?
